

## **Supporting Documentation - Home**

Thank you for taking the time to look in more detail at our project.

As we have mentioned, this year 2008 we are refurbishing a derelict building into a fully equipt Children's home, with 2 full time Haitian Staff. The Home planned to open in January 2009, and home upto 15 children, and will service as a base for health and education outreach projects with street children and AIDs orphans.

We are looking to raise £6,000 (\$12,000) to complete this refurbishment.

In the surrounding area of Cap-Haitien in the North of the Island, there is an urgent need for improved medical facilities. The local Medical Director has advised that the first priority should be to Maternity and infant health care.

With this in mind, we have started construction of 4 buildings that will make up the Maternity and Paediatric units and wards.

We will shortly start recruiting new staff, but experienced staff, and be able to offer an opportunity for Staff adoption / sponsorship.

The Haiti Hospital Appeal is a small charity dependant on private donations, and is run by a team of volunteers, we have no UK Office overheads and we have only one part time paid worker in the UK. Because of this your donations will have a massive impact to this project.

This is such an effective Grass roots project. We have been on 6 trips and have never had a problem, however the British Foreign Office does recommend that people don't travel to Haiti unless it is essential. We believe our work in Haiti is essential – Obviously we do take the safety of our volunteers very seriously and ensure they stay in secure accommodation. You can come out to Haiti and see exactly where your donation went and what we were able to do with and meet the people it helped at first hand. We are happy to arrange trips and advise on cost, vaccinations and visas.
